This holy time spent with our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament is a time for Jesus to lead you and for you to poor out your heart to him. Young children can make a good Holy Half Hour with direction, so do not fret if they get a little fidgety, and again resources will be made available.

Parent Sessions

The Church has always recognized that Parents are the first and foremost Catechist in their child's life. At the same time, she (the Church) shoulders this responsibility with the parents and ministers to people of all ages.
