

Music for the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God

At the end of one year and beginning of the next, there is the ability to earn an plenary indulgence (the remission of the temporal punishment due to sin that remains after absolution).

The usual requirements: Receive Sacramental Confession (within 20 days prior or after), Receive Holy Communion, Pray for the Intentions of the Holy Father, be free from any attachments to sin, and be intentional about the indulgence act.

The act for the indulgence for December 31st is to sing/pray the "Te Deum" publically. The indulgence for January 1st is to sing/pray the "Veni, Creator Spiritus." These are our respective Closing Hymns (English Translations).
